## **Articles of Faith and Practice**

- 1. We believe in God the Eternal Father, who only is Supreme; Creator of the universe; Ruler and Judge of all; unchangeable and without respect of persons.
- 2. We believe in Jesus Christ the manifestation of God in flesh, who lived, suffered, and died for all mankind; whom we own as our only Leader, Witness, and Commander.
- 3. We believe in the Holy Ghost, the Spirit of Truth, the Comforter, which searcheth the deep things of God, brings to our minds things which are past, reveals this to come, and is the medium by which we receive the revelation of Jesus Christ
- 4. We believe that men will be punished for their own sins and not for Adam's transgression, and that as a consequence of the atonement of Christ "all little children are alive in Christ, and also all they that are without the Law. For the power of redemption cometh on all they that have no law; wherefore, he that is not condemned, or he that is under no condemnation, cannot repent, and unto such, baptism availeth nothing." (Moroni 8.22)
- 5. We believe that through the atonement of Christ all men may be saved by obedience to the laws and ordinances of the gospel; viz.: Faith in God and in the Lord Jesus Christ; Repentance and Baptism by immersion for the remission of sins; Laying on of Hands for: (a) Ordination; (b) Blessing of Children: (c) Confirmation and the gift of the Holy Ghost (Acts 8:17); (d) Healing of the sick.
- 6. We believe in the literal second coming and millennial reign of Jesus Christ; in the resurrection of the Dead, and in Eternal Judgment; that men will be rewarded or punished according to the good or evil they may have done.
- 7. We believe in the powers and gifts of the everlasting Gospel; viz.: The word of wisdom; the word of knowledge; the gift of faith; the gift of healing; working of miracles; prophecy; discerning of spirits; divers kinds of tongues; interpretation of tongues.
- 8. We believe the fruits of the Spirit to be love, joy, peace, long suffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness and temperance.
- 9. We believe that in the Bible is contained the Word of God; that The Record of the Nephites is the added witness for Christ; and these contain the "fullness of the gospel."
- 10. We believe in the principle of continuous revelation; that the canon of scripture is not full, that God inspires men in every age and among all people, and that He speaks when, where, and through whom He may choose.
- 11. We believe that where there are six or more regularly baptized members, one of whom is an elder, there the Church exists with full power of Church extension when acting in harmony with the Law of God.
- 12. We believe that man must be called of God by revelation and ordained by those having authority, to enable him to preach the Gospel and administer the Ordinances thereof.
- 13. We believe in the same Church organization as existed in the time of Christ and His apostles. The highest office in the Church is that of an apostle, of whom there are twelve, who constitute special witnesses for Jesus Christ. They have the Missionary Supervision and the General Watchcare of all the Churches.
- 14. The primary function of the General Church, of which each Local Church is a component part, is missionary and the building up and extension of the Kingdom of God in all

the world.

- 15. We believe that Local Churches should govern their own affairs and that General Church officials should not dominate or interfere therewith. On invitation such general officers may, with propriety, give counsel and assistance. Local congregations are subject to the Articles of Faith and Practice and must be governed thereby.
- 16. We believe The Church of Christ comprehends the true brotherhood of man where each esteems his brother as himself and wherein the Divine command to "love your neighbor as yourself" is demonstrated by the prevalence of social equality.
- 17. We believe that all men are stewards under God and answerable to Him not only for the distribution of accumulated wealth, but for the manner in which such wealth is secured. The primary purpose of stewardship is not the increase of church revenue or the mere contribution of money by those who have to those who have not, but to bring men to a realization of the common fatherhood and the universal brotherhood of man in all the affairs and expressions of life, and to maintain such social adjustments that each may enjoy the bounty and gifts of God, and be free to exercise his talents and ability to enrich the life of all.
- 18. We believe that men should labor for their own support and that of their dependents. Ministers of the Gospel are not absolved from this responsibility, but when chosen or appointed by the Church to devote their entire time to missionary work, their families are to be provided for out of the General Church fund. The admonition of Christ that ministry should not provide purse or scrip for their journey, but go trusting in God and the people, is applicable.
- 19. We believe that the temporal affairs of the General Church are to be administered by the general bishopric under the supervision and direction of general conferences of the Church. The temporal affaires of the Local Churches shall be administered by local bishops under the supervision and direction of the local congregations.
- 20. We believe that marriage is ordained of God, and that the Law of God provides for but one companion in wedlock for either man or woman. In case of a breach of this covenant the innocent one may remarry.
- 21. We believe oppose to war. Men are not justified in taking up of arms against their fellows except as a last resort in defense of their lives and to preserve their liberty.
- 22. We believe in the literal gathering of Israel, and in the restoration of the ten lost tribes.
- 23. We believe a Temple will be built in this generation, in Independence, Missouri, wherein Christ will reveal Himself and endow His servants whom He chooses with power to preach the Gospel in all the world to every kindred, tongue, and people, that the promise of God to Israel may be fulfilled.
- 24. We believe that New Jerusalem shall be built upon this land "unto the remnant of the seed of Joseph, (Ether 6:6-8; III Nephi 10.1-4), which city shall be built, beginning at the Temple Lot."
- 25. We believe that ministry and membership should abstain from the use of tobacco, intoxicating liquors and narcotics, and should not affiliate with any society which administer oaths or covenants in conflict with the Law of God, or which interfere with their duties as freemen and citizens.

# Introduction

## To All People

Dear reader,

On behalf of the members of The Church of Christ with the Elijah Message, the Assured Way of the Lord, I want to welcome all of our new and returning brothers and sister in East Africa. You are the reason for this Special Edition of the Greater Light. We love you and give thanks for each and every one of you. Jesus said to "Remember yea are the Body of Christ, the Church, and members in particular." He has promised "The Church of Christ will never again be destroyed..." - Message 117:1 and 92:8.

I also must give thanks to our brother Mobutu and for all he has done for the Lord. I told him I would like to do this report when he returned and Sister Ellen Draves suggested making it a Special Edition. Thank you, my dear brother, and also our sisters Ellen, Ruby and Joy Draves for helping me with the final editing and formatting of it. I have included some of the pictures he has sent me and tried to help me match them with the events that took place. Please forgive any errors in the placement.

This mission to East Africa and its purpose included two parts. There were new converts from separate denominational churches to be baptized and receive the flow of this Holy Priesthood Authority to represent Christ and His Church. There were former members that were asking for baptisms and reconciliation. They had become confused and persuaded to follow the claims and proclaims of other groups being led by former members of our church causing more divisions and separations in the House of God in this Hour of Judgment.

There was a calling for our new Apostle Meshack Kebasi to be ordained. Apostle

Jairus was contacted here by those there. He has worked tirelessly with Brother Mobutu and the other Apostles to bring it to pass for those on the East side of Africa. What our brother Mobutu faced was like biblical times when traveling to other nations during this time of trouble that is filled with dangers. All these were overcome by his patience with the protection and hand of our Lord to sustain him against physical and spiritual enemies. Praise God!

This mission, when finished, would be from Friday, February 26, 2021 through Monday June 7, 2021, and would include a special three day assembly.

In the words of our brother and Apostle Mobutu in Africa, I quote: "There was no means to meet during 2020 up to now since there was no way to gather people together due to Covid-19. As you know these divisions gave hatred and conflicts in most of our church members here in Africa with those of other groups, particular in Kenya and Uganda in East Africa.

The former church members from the United States challenged many people in Kenya, and Uganda, with some messages they said they received from God. Most of our members started to be confused since they had waited for a long time knowing that the messenger will come again. This is the reasons why we planned to call our ministry from March 25, 26 and 27, 2021. This will help us to train all of them at once instead of wasting much time to go in each local. We planned to meet with them in our Chwele local, or to hire a hall in Bungoma or an area that will be easy for all of them to reach.

Please continue to pray for us as we are doing the same to you."

When you read the report you will see God's hand was upon our Brother Mobutu protecting him and helping him complete his mission. If you have read now or have read the messages before concerning this work in Africa and the world in this day and time and you have (spiritual) ears to hear and eyes to see you will find knowledge and understanding of the Truth. It should humble you to know that God has power to do all things according to His Words found in the Word of the Lord with its 120 messages given to date.

We have discernment that these words are true by the Spirit of Truth that is the Spirit of Christ.

This very same Spirit revealed the Truth to those that received our brother Mobutu and believed Him.

# AFRICAN MISSIONARY REPORT

February 26 2021 - June 7, 2021 performed in East Africa By Apostle Bama wa Mobutu Gloire



My dearest brothers and sisters,

This is to thank God and all of you who prayed for me and supported me in different ways spiritually, temporally, emotionally, financially and morally and in difficulties times.

Spiritually I was very strong because I was number one to tell our members: "Fear not, this will come and pass and we shall not die all of us at once. Those God prepared to die with Covid-19 will go others will continue to serve God here on Earth."

My journey started here. When I was ready to travel, I went to take the official permit for the Covid-19 certificate in order to cross the border.

My body became very weak, I thought now here will be the place I will be contaminated with this virus, I started to tremble, but I felt Angels came, to strengthen me, all fear removed in me. I felt a voice telling me, "fear is a weapon that Satan will use to destroy you" then I started praying.

I started my prayers of fasting, I promised God to sustain me, I decided not to eat or drink anything there, as I thought in my mind that all their items was contaminated already.

The first result came on Monday, March 1st, 2021 afternoon, it was negative, the second test on Tuesday March 2, 2021 was negative, the third test on Wednesday March 3rd, 2021was negative, the fourth on Thursday March 4, 2021 was negative too. Every day they were taking the tests. On Friday March 5, 2021 it was also negative.

From March 10, 2021, I planned to start the journey but it was not easy since on March 5 they continued to check me. I was supposed to wait 10 days before I could travel and my 10 days was supposed to go until March 15, 2021.

I talked to Brother Meshack Kebasi of Kisii in Kenya by phone. They proposed that I will be there from March 13 and 14. Brother Walubengo Rastors told me to be in their place from March 19, 2021.

Yesterday on Monday March 8, 2021, I finished with the people testing me for Covid-19, but they checked once again and I am negative. Now I will be ready to travel.

On Saturday March 13, 2021, I wrote: Be sure to continue to pray for me. I know this missionary work will not be easy, but I must go and do the Lord's will. I will start to travel on Tuesday, March 16, 2021. I was vaccinated for yellow fever, and they told me to wait until 10 days before traveling. It will be completed on Monday March 15, 2021.

I finished my 14 days of lockdown for Covid-19, and I am negative. Thank you for your prayers and support.

I started the missionary trip on Tuesday,

March 16, 2021. Travelling this time is not like before due to Covid-19. When I crossed the border to Uganda, they took us into lockdown for 5 days in a hotel called Corona Hotel from Wednesday, March 17, 2021, Thursday March 18, 2021, Friday, March 19, 2021, Saturday, March 20, 2021, and Sunday, March 21. I moved into the Corona Hotel on Monday, March 22, 2021.

All their check-ups went well and I was still negative. Still free from Covid-19 up to that date of Monday, March 22, 2021. God opened for us the way, everything goes well. On the same Monday, March 22, 2021, in the morning I took the bus at 10:00 AM and travelled all that day. Since I was very tired, body and mind due to anxieties and troubles on the way because of the Covid-19 issues. I spent 2 nights in Kampala City of Uganda in order to rest and recover new energy in order to continue with my trip with a long journey again from Kampala to Kenya.

I had no information and precision about the Covid-19 in Kenya border and the date I will be in Kenya, because I don't have that information yet. At the Kenya border how it will be? I decided to plan everything fresh once I reach Kenya.

After meeting with Brother Walubengo Rastors and Meshack Kebasi and once they come this way, I planned to meet with them and our ministry and members in Kenya for 3 days as an emergency and extra-ordinary General Assembly.

That assembly will help us to train them, building the capacity, reconciliation and accepting each other. There was no means to meet during 2020 up to now since there was no way to gather people together due to Covid-19. As you know these divisions gave hatred and conflicts in most of our church members here in Africa because of the other groups, particular in Kenya and Uganda in East Africa. This is the reason

why we planned to call our ministry from March 25, 26 and 27, 2021. This will help us to train all of them all at once instead of wasting much time by going to each local.

We planned to meet with them in our Chwele local, or to hire a hall in Bungoma or an area that will be easy to all of them to reach.

On Wednesday, March 24, 2021, I had conversation with Brother David Odong of Uganda. Brother David Odong replied to me.

"Thank you very much Brother, thanks for your email. I am Pastor Odong in Eastern Uganda (East Africa). I welcome and thank you for the work of the Lord. Democratic Republic of Congo is just the neighbour of Uganda in east if possible we can arrange so that i come and meet you there.

Thank you, Pastor Odong David."

On the same day Wednesday, March 24, 2021, at 8:00 AM. We reached at the border at 6:00 PM local Uganda time.

Thursday, March 25, 2021, I went for Covid-19 check-up at the border, because before to enter the immigration we need to start with the Covid-19 office first, I again tested negative.

March 28, 2021, they stamped my Covid-19 certificate and allowed me to move in Corona Hotel and go to get the exit visa at Uganda immigration office and proceed to Kenya. After many days at the border of Kenya and Uganda, my test and check-up on Covid-19, came back negative, and they allowed me finally to enter Kenya.

We entered Kenya on Sunday, March 28, 2021, and on Monday, March 29, 2021, at 8:00 AM, I left Malaba border to Bungoma Kenya. I reached Bungoma Kenya at 9:00 AM. Brothers were waiting for me there at the KANDUYI INN hotel. We

started the meeting there for six hours, from 10:00 AM up to 4:00 PM.

I was in the meeting with some Brothers in Bungoma Kenya and planned about the general assembly that we postponed. It was supposed to start last week March 25-27. But due to the lockdown we had at the border, we changed that date for this week from Friday, April 2 to Sunday.

April 4, 2021. We agreed to gather people at our Chwele local Church of Christ with the Elijah Message the Assured way of the Lord in Kenya East Africa.

I left Bungoma on Tuesday, March 30, 2021, at 7:00 AM, I took the bus up to Nairobi, capital city of Kenya. The same day Tuesday, March 30, 2021, I reached Nairobi at 2:00 PM.

I took at once another shuttle express bus to Kisumu city of Nyanza province through Kericho. We reached Kisumu at 6:00 PM where they changed us to another express shuttle bus from Kisumu to Kisii.

We reached in Kisii town on Tuesday, March 30, 2021, at 8:00 PM. I took the hotel and took a shower and slept.

We talked to Brother Meshack Kebasi. He promised to reach where I was tomorrow Wednesday, March 31, 2021. Then he came, in the morning.

After food he took us to visit His family and home that is 30 kilometers from Kisii town, where we meet there his 2 boys, their wives and children.

Without to delay, we started discussions and teachings with them, they all agreed with baptism and accepted to join our church. He returned me to Kisii town at the same hotel, where I slept the second day.

Tomorrow on Thursday, April 1, 2021 at 8:00 AM, Brother Meshack came to pick me up from the hotel up to the church where I met with other leaders and members.

I started teachings with them from 9:00 AM. They accepted baptism.

There is a son of Brother Meshack Kebasi who had a Pentecostal denominational Church and he was not working with His father. I had a length of time of discussions with him, until I converted him to join our church. I baptized him and some of his members and his wife. God helped me. I brought him to be reconciled with His father Meshack Kebasi and to work together as a team in this work.

We baptized 18 members of the Kisii Local.

More than 15 locals are still calling us for their baptism and a report received that forty more have been baptized since I returned home to Ariwara. The 304 people baptized and ordained so far are divided as follows:

- 1. Kitale Local- 40 people.
- 2. Amuka Local- 55 people.
- 3. Mengo Local- 45 people.
- 4. Chenjeni local- 55 people.
- 5. Lumboka Local- 40 people.
- 6. Kisii Local- 18 people.
- 7. Chwele Local- 50 people.

We are returning 5 local church building and 4 pièce of lands. The 200 x 200 feets of land we get in Kisii is value is Kshs 400,000. Équivalent to US \$4,000. We returned already 12 church properties buildings and 4 empty lands.

I have reached the Democratic Republic of Congo Bunia local from Kenya and Uganda East Africa, on Sunday, May 30, 2021, at 6:00 PM. Evening local ours. God through your prayers opened the way and I entered Uganda.

On Sunday, May 30, 2021, at 9:00 AM, we started our Journey from the border of Uganda, we crossed into D.R. Congo and travel all over the day, then we reached Bunia at 6:00 PM.

I spent 1 week in Bunia local as we had a baptism this week and then on Monday, June 7, 2021, I proceeded to Ariwara.
