Articles of Faith and Practice

1. We believe in God The Eternal Father, who only is Supreme; Creator of the Universe; Ruler and Judge of all; Unchangeable and without Respect to persons.
2. We believe in Jesus Christ The Manifestation of God in the flesh, who lived, suffered and died for all mankind; whom we own as our Leader, Witness and Commander.
3. We believe in The Holy Ghost, The Spirit of Truth, The Comforter, which searcheth the deep things of God, brings to our minds things which are past, Reveals things to come, and is the medium by which we Receive Revelation of Jesus Christ.
4. We believe that men will be punished for their own sins and not for Adam's transgression, and that as a consequence of The Atonement of Christ "all little children are alive in Christ, and also all they that are without The Law. For The Power of Redemption cometh on all they that have no law; wherefore, he that is not condemned, or he that is under no condemnation, cannot repent, and unto such, baptism availeth nothing." (Moroni 8:22)
5. We believe that through The Atonement of Christ all men may be Saved by Obedience to The Laws and Ordinances of The Gospel; viz. : Faith in God and in The Lord Jesus Christ; Repentance and Baptism by immersion for the remission of sins; Laying on of Hands for: (a) Ordination, (b) Blessing of Children, (c) Confirmation and The Gift of the Holy Ghost (Acts 8:17), (d) Healing of the sick.
6. We believe in the literal second coming and Millennial Reign of Jesus Christ; in The Resurrection of the Dead, and in Eternal Judgment; that men will be rewarded or punished according to the good or evil they may have done.
7. We believe in The Powers and Gifts of The Everlasting Gospel: viz: The Word of Wisdom; The Word of Knowledge; The Gift of Faith; The Gift of Healing; Working of Miracles; Prophecy; Discerning of Spirits; Divers kinds of Tongues; Interpretation of Tongues.
8. We believe The Fruits of The Spirit to be Love, Joy, Peace, Long Suffering, Gentleness, Goodness, Faith, Meekness, and Temperance.
9. We believe that in The Bible is contained The Word of God; that The Record of the Nephites is an added Witness for Christ, and that these contain 'The Fullness of The Gospel.'
10. We believe in the principle of Continuous Revelation; that The Canon of Scripture is not full, that God Inspires men in every age and among all people, and that He speaks when, where, and through whom he may choose.
11. We believe that where there are six or more regularly Baptized members, one of whom is an Elder, there The Church exists with Full Power of Church extension when acting in Harmony with The Law of God.
12. We believe that a man must be Called of God by Revelation and Ordained by those having Authority, to enable him to Preach The Gospel and Administer The Ordinances thereof.
13. We believe in the same Church Organization as existed in the time of Christ and His apostles. The highest office in The Church is that of an Apostle, of whom there are Twelve, who constitute Special Witnesses for Jesus Christ. They have The Missionary Supervision and The General Watch care of all The Churches.
14. The primary function of The General Church, of which each Local Church is a component part, is Missionary and the building up and extension of The Kingdom of God in all the world.
15. We believe that Local Churches should govern their own affairs and that General Church officials should not dominate or interfere therewith. On invitation such general officers may, with propriety, give counsel and assistance. Local congregations are subject to The Articles of Faith and Practice and must be governed thereby.
16. We believe The Church of Christ comprehends The True Brotherhood of man where each esteems his brother as himself and wherein The Divine Command to 'love your neighbor as yourself' is demonstrated by the prevalence of social equality.
17. We believe that all men are Stewards under God and answerable to Him not only for the distribution of accumulated wealth, but for the manner in which such wealth is secured. The primary purpose of Stewardship is not the increase of Church revenue or the mere contribution of money by those who have to those who have not, but to bring men to a realization of The Common Fatherhood and the universal brotherhood of man in all the affairs and expressions of life, and to maintain such social adjustments that each may enjoy The Bounty and Gifts of God, and be free to exercise his talents and ability to enrich the life of all.
18. We believe that men should labor for their own support and that of their dependents. Ministers of The Gospel are not absolved from this responsibility, but when Chosen or Appointed by The Church to devote their entire time to Missionary Work, their families are to be provided for out of General Church fund. The Admonition of Christ that The Ministry should not provide purse or scrip for their journey, but go Trusting in God and the people, is applicable.
19. We believe that the temporal affairs of the General Church are to be administered by The General Bishopric under the supervision and direction of the general conferences of The Church. The temporal affairs of The Local Churches shall be Administered by local Bishops under the supervision and direction of the local congregations.
20. We believe that marriage is Ordained of God, and that The Law of God provides for but one companion in wedlock for either man or woman. In case of breach of this covenant the innocent one may remarry.
21. We are opposed to war. Men are not justified in taking up arms against their fellows except as a last resort in defense of their lives and to preserve their liberty.
22. We believe in The Literal gathering of Israel, and in The Restoration of The Ten Lost Tribes.
23. We believe a Temple will be Built in this generation, in Independence, Missouri, wherein Christ will Reveal Himself and Endow His Servants whom He Chooses with Power to Preach The Gospel in all the world to every kindred, tongue and people, that The Promise of God to Israel may be Fulfilled.
24. We believe that a New Jerusalem shall be Built upon this land 'unto The Remnant' of The Seed of Joseph. (Ether 6:6-8; III Nephi 10:17), which city be Built, beginning at The Temple Lot.
25. We believe The Ministry and Membership should abstain from the use of tobacco, intoxicating liquors and narcotics and should not affiliate with any society which administer Oaths or Covenants in conflict with The Law of God, or which interfere with their duties as freemen and citizens.

everything written in *The Articles of Faith and Practice*.

It is each Elder's duty to Seek Guidance from and to keep The Territorial Apostle informed of his works in the region he is laboring.

THE GREATER LIGHT, the official publication of *The Church of Christ With The Elijah Message, The Assured Way of The Lord, Inc.*, comes to YOU as an expression of the Hope we have in Christ.

In its pages are found the thoughts and expression of a united people, whose only aim is to promote *The Cause of Christ* by spreading abroad to every nation, tongue and people, *The True Gospel of Christ* that through Obedience to His Laws we might be found worthy of *Eternal Life*.

In this publication, *The Record of The Nephites* is quoted many times. This Book was Revealed and Translated by *The Gift and Power of God*: the year 1829 marked the beginning of *The Restoration of all things*. It is a history of the people who once lived in the region around *The Great Lakes*, some of whom are Ancestors of The American Indians. Though it contains a Record of two other groups of people who once lived here, it is for the most part a Record of The People of Nephi.

The Messages so often mentioned in this publication are Messages from The Lord, brought to earth by His Chosen Servant, John The Baptist, who comes to earth in a Glorified Body to finish The Work given to him of God; that of Restoring all things (Matthew 17:11-13). The Angel

first came in 1829, and Restored *The Authority Of The Son Of God*, that *The Church of Christ* might be Established as in The Days of The Apostles.

In 1927, The Angel Messenger again appeared, and on numerous subsequent visits, has brought to us ***The Word Of The Lord*** that *The Church of Christ* might be set in Order, that a people might be Prepared to be *The Bride Of Christ*. This is *The Elijah Message* so many have looked for, *The Midnight Cry* has been Proclaimed, *A Warning of Destruction*, but to *The People Of The Lord*, a Message that Christ's soon Coming is near at hand. Fear God and give *Glory to His Name*, for *The Hour of His Judgment* has come. Awake thou that sleepest and Arise from the dead, and Christ will give you *Light*.

We hope that whosoever reads these pages might make it a matter of Prayer and Fasting in Humility before God, that they may know for themselves, that God has again Spoken and Revealed *His Will* from Heaven. To this end, we Dedicate ***The Greater Light***.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Mark the date on your calendar and plan to attend the 2016 General Assembly! The Lord wants us to come together in unity to pray, to testify of His goodness in your life, and learn more about His great gospel!

God tells us to attend services.

Message 81:17 “Let all come to attendance to exhortations to Doctrine that greater Light may come, and it will be those that prepare for it, unto the measure of Christ, in all things showing good works.”

Message 44:18 “...Let them take up this duty to encourage all even the young to attend services...”

Message 104:26 “Let all awaken to their Calling and help more in this Work, attending services, worship and working among the people.”

Message 107:13 “Let there be peace in your gatherings and the weakness will turn to strength. Arise from lethargy. Swing wide the gate. Let the Lord’s people come all the way to this Plan of Deliverance—

receive a new heart and abundance of the God’s Spirit and deliverance will be made sure.”

Message 73:8 “Let your assembling be, that, filled with peace. Let the Lord be honored. Let your conversations be yea, yea, and nay, nay and no evil will come among you. Defend the truth and crush the evil. Be pleasant in your doings. I speak to all that will heed. Defile not the Holy Rites but keep sacred the Plan of God.”

Scriptures tell us to testify of the truth of God that is in us and to testify of the goodness of God and of how God has worked in your life.

Moroni 6:5-9 “And the Church did meet together oft, to fast and to pray, and to speak one with another concerning the welfare of their souls; And they did met together oft to partake of bread and wine, in remembrance of the Lord Jesus; And they were strict to observe that there should be no iniquity among them...; But as oft as they repented, and sought forgiveness with real intent, they were forgiven. And their meetings were conducted by the Church, after the manner of the workings of the Spirit, and by the power of the Holy Ghost; for as the power of the Holy Ghost led them whether to preach, or exhort, or to pray, or to supplicate or to sing, even so it was done.”

I Peter 3:15 “But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear:”

Philemon 1:4-7 “I thank my God making mention of thee always in my prayers, Hearing of thy love and faith, which thou hast toward the Lord Jesus,

and toward all saints; That the communication of thy faith may become effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus. For we have great joy and consolation in thy love, because the bowels of the saints are refreshed by thee, brother.”

Psalm 95:1-2, 6 “O come let us sing unto the Lord; let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation. Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto Him with psalms...O come let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the Lord our maker.”

Psalm 105:1-5 “O give thanks unto the Lord: call upon His name: make known His deeds among the people. Sing unto Him, sing psalms unto Him: talk ye of His wondrous works. Glory ye in His Holy name: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the Lord. Seek the Lord and His strength: seek His face forevermore. Message 34:4 “Even now I say to my servants, meet in your solemn Assembly. Cry mightily unto Me, and I will hear you, and manifest My will unto you, yea, concerning Zion. Let My Law be taught in its completeness that the joy of man might be full under the Plan of Redemption. Yea, men are that they might have joy, and according to their faith I manifest My Will unto mankind. Because of unbelief My Work has suffered, leaving many to wander in darkness.”

Message 35:3 “The cries of My people have come up before Me, and I have heard their Humble plea,’ saith your God. ‘Yea, I am pleading for you to continue to come close unto Me. Behold many have obeyed Me in that they have come humbly to this Assembly. I led you here one and all and My wish is that you remain very humble before Me; then I will continue to bless you and lead you close unto Me. Be very humble that the Sunlight of Righteousness from the Lamb of God may shine on you with healing in His power.”

Message 39:23 “Be kind to those that come to learn or truth. Meet in the Assembly and cry mightily unto the Lord, for many shall come to learn the truth. Be not contentious but let the Lord direct.”

Message 41:6 “...Gather in your Assembly in peace and be kind to all men...”

Message 42:2 “...Meet in your Assembly in peace and let the Lord by His spirit

remain among you. Behold, the Lord will meet with you, for truly this shall be the beginning of great things to come to pass.”

Message 43:26 “The Lord has accepted the humbleness and solemnness of His people of this Assembly and if you will continue to be thus before Him, He will make you a blessing...”

Message 54:13 “...Be humble and let your Light shine. Be at peace with all men. Come before Me in humility and meet in your Assembly and I will meet with you. Love one another; bear ye each others burdens. Remember that I have suffered for you that a Way of Deliverance might be. Behold, I will give greater Light and Power as My people will prepare for it.”

Message 60:12 “Gather in the Assembly and cry unto the Lord. Let no evil come among you. The Lord will hear all those that repent and obey His Will. Let your prayers be of the heart. Let no contentions be found among you.”

Message 92:3 “The Lord’s people have seen trials and afflictions but let all arise to a closer walk with the Lord. Come away from contentions and bring love and obedience in your lives. Continue in good

works. The Lord has heard the prayers that are of the heart, and this assembly. And I bring peace and an answer to the problems when it becometh a need.”

Message 93:5 “The Lord has heard the prayers in behalf of His people and this Assembly. He has blessed and spoken by the Spirit of Revelation; revealing much.”

Message 95:8 “Your gatherings and assembling have been good in sight of the Lord. Keep the Lord’s Spirit among you. Command peace and stand firm, all you faithful.”

Message 97:20 “Meet in your assembly in peace, let no contention be among you.”

Message 105:8 “Even now the Lord instructs all to meet in your solemn assembling, and cry mightily unto Him. He will hear and manifest His Will unto you—even concerning Zion.

Heed God’s prompting to attend the 2016 General Assembly! Make this assembly a priority! Do all you can to attend! Come in humility with a prayer upon your heart that we may cry mightily unto the Lord together! Fourth Message

How many of you looked at the Message in the front of the paper? There are two things wrong with it. First it was called Fourth Visitation. This was what the first messages were called. The Message Book was called *Revelations on the Building of the Temple*. It contained 12 Visitations instead of Messages.

The Second Message book that was printed contained 26 Messages and they were called Messages in this book. The name of it was *A Warning to All People of the Second Coming of Christ*.

On January 28, 1933 John the Baptist came and gave the 30th Message. The Messenger unrolled the roll on which was written, “The Word of the Lord.” So after the Thirtieth Message this was the name of the book.

I should get back to the Fourth Message. Message 30:9 “Publish the fourth message. What is it to you?...” Did you ever wonder why these sentences were in the Message?

The reason for this is it was not put in the book until after the Thirtieth Message. Brother Fetting withheld the Message from the brethren. After Otto Fetting passed away his wife, Jennie, found the message in the safe which had been set aside by itself. Thereafter all future books included the Fourth Message as it is written below.

Fourth Message

1. The last time I came to you, I brought a message of warning to you. Read it, and with it I also warned you of the losses that you would have unless you heeded the warning. I told you that this was a time of haste. Now the time has come when you will have greater losses. Come with me

and I will show you a vision of the future.

2. Remember there are trying times ahead that will affect the whole world, and much will come to pass. That great church the mother of harlots, the abomination of all the earth is working against all governments to overthrow them, and it is also working with all its power and helpers to overthrow this government, that she may establish herself upon this land. Remember Satan has great power, and many will be deceived by his power.

3. Release yourself from the business world. Seek not after riches, but seek to warn the world, and save the honest in heart from destruction. Weep not over the losses you will have, for they will be many. Many trials will come to you. Remember, I have told you.

4. The time has come that the words he gave to the churches will come to pass and the judgments will come upon the earth. The abominations will flourish until God will send his angels to reap the harvest of the wicked and Satan will be bound.

5. Many will not be true to the work that God will place upon them, and Satan will try you also, for there is great danger ahead. Let not the riches of this world or the praise of men lead you to destruction.

6. I will come to you from time to time, to instruct you in many things that will come to pass, and the great work that must be done.

You would think there is nothing in this message that should warrant it to not be published when it was first given. But you need to look at what was going on in the world at this time.

During this time the Catholic Church was building churches throughout the United States. It was getting people into

public offices all over the world. Later we had a man that ran for President. He was a Catholic. The people were afraid that if he won the Pope would be giving instructions to him and we would be losing our rights. They were afraid that the Catholic Church would take over this country. This feeling was expressed by several religious groups.

Because of the atmosphere of the country at this time, Otto felt that the message should not be published and the Lord allowed this for almost six years.

In future when you read the messages, don't just read them, study them thoroughly and try to find why the Lord gave it and what was taking place in the church and the world. He never leaves us without a warning but he wants us to study to be approved. Will you be one of the proven that the Lord speaks of?

Honor Your Father and Mother

The fifth commandment that the Lord gave us is "Honor thy father and mother, that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee." Exodus 20:12.

Some people may read this and think it is a reward. The reason for this is that if you build a society based on children honoring their parents the society will survive. On the other side of the coin a society that does not honor their parents is doomed to self destruction.

Why is it that honoring our parents is so important? One reason is that we, as children, need it. In this generation we have seen the consequences of growing up with-

out a father. Fatherless boys are more likely to grow up and commit crimes, mistrust women and act against society in every other way. Girls who do not have a father to honor are more likely to seek the wrong men and to be promiscuous at an early age.

Why Should We Honor Our Parents

It is the right thing to do. Ephesians 6:1-3 “Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right. Honor thy father and mother (which is the first commandment with promise), That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth.” We owe our parents our life and gratitude. They have sacrificed so much for us. We don’t realize this until we become parents.

The Bible tells us that disobedience to the parents will be one of the signs of the end time. In II Timothy 3:1-2 “This know, also, that in the last days perilous times shall come. For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy.” Is this the society of today? The family is in trouble. We need to study God’s word for solutions.

It pleases God to honor our parents. “Children, obey your parents in all things; for this is well pleasing unto the Lord.” If you notice this verse says to obey your parents. And that is pleasing unto the Lord. This puts honoring your parents on a spiritual level.

Honoring our parents teaches us to respect authority. Ezekiel 22:7 “In thee have they set light by father and mother; in the midst of thee have they dealt by oppression with the strangers; in thee have they vexed

the fatherless and the widow.” Ezekiel 22:15 “And I will scatter thee among the heathen, and disperse thee in the countries, and will consume thy filthiness out of thee.”

Now go to Romans 13: 1-2 “Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but of God...and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation.”

We see the loss of authority for the parents in many ways – absentee parents, the abdication of authority promoted by permissive parenting styles, even government interferences with some aspects of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child. A prime example of this is that you should not spank your child. Proverbs 13:24 “He that spareth his rod hateth his son; but he that loveth him chasteneth him betimes.” We do not say that you should beat your child, but a little swat on the bottom shows the child that you are the one with the authority. Today’s children have grown up with the idea that if they are swatted they are abused and therefore they can sue their parents. In this process they have now lost respect for authority.

The authorities that exist have been established by God. When you rebel against your parents, you are really rebelling against authority, and you are rebelling against God as the ultimate authority.

You are under God’s protection when you honor your father and mother. “My son, keep thy father’s commandment, and forsake not the law of thy mother: Bind them continually upon thine heart, and tie them about thy neck. When thou goest, it shall lead thee; and when thou awakest, it shall talk with thee; For the commandment is a lamp, and the law is light, and reproofs

of instruction are the way of life.” Proverbs 6: 20-23. In Proverbs whenever it talks about the lamp going out, it means a person’s life is being cut short.

We should live righteously. Proverbs 23:24-25 ‘The father of the righteous shall greatly rejoice, and he that begetteth a wise child shall have joy of him. Thy father and thy mother shall be glad, and she that bore thee shall rejoice. In Proverbs 27:11 Solomon says “My son, be wise, and make my heart glad, that I may answer him that reproacheth me.”

It helps you grow in wisdom when you honor your parents. Look at Proverbs 4:1-4 “Hear, ye children, the instructions of a father, and attend to know understanding; For I give you good doctrine; forsake ye not my law. For I was my father’s son, tender and only beloved in the sight of my mother. He taught me also, and said unto me, Let thine heart retain my words; keep my commandments, and live.”

Parents are teachers of faith and morality. What God is to the world, parents are to their children. Parents have molded their children so their children will have the drive to serve the Lord.

We should listen attentively to what they tell us. Proverbs 23:22 “Hearken unto thy father that begot thee, and despise not thy mother when she is old.” The key word is listen. It means to pay attention. As your parents age you should keep in touch with them. You should listen to them even thou some of the stories they have told you, you have heard several times. Every time we would go to Warrensburg, we would pass this barn. Mom would always say I went to many dances in that old barn. We would listen to her and just laugh without her knowing it. I would give anything to

hear these stories now.

Jesus rebuked the Pharisees of his day for neglecting their parents. “But he answered and said unto them, Why do ye also transgress the commandments of God by your traditions? For God commanded, saying, Honor thy father and mother; and, He that curseth father or mother, let him die the death. But ye say, Whosoever shall say to his father or his mother, It is a gift, by whatsoever thou mightest be profited by me; And honor not his father or his mother, he shall be free. Thus have ye made the commandment of God of none effect by your traditions.”

The ancient Greeks believed that you should lose your rights as a citizen if you did not support your parents in old age. This occurred when you failed to provide for them.

Promises

God has attached great and precious promises to the fifth commandment. There are two of them. Exodus 20:12 “Honor thy father and thy mother, that thy days may be long upon the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.” Deuteronomy 5:16 “Honor thy father and thy mother, as the Lord by God hath commanded thee, that thy days may be prolonged, and that it may go well with thee in the land which the Lord thy God giveth thee.” Ephesians 6:2-3 “Honor thy father and mother (which is the first commandment with promise), That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth.” Simply put, your life will go better if you honor your parents. You avoid many of the dangers that can cut life short or cut off the enjoyment of life, and thus as a rule, they live longer and better. This is the way God designed it to be.

In conclusion this reminds me of the

song “The Cat’s in the Cradle” by Henry Chaplin. The song is about a man who is too busy to spend time with his son. The son goes to college and then starts working and is too busy to spend time with his father. The chorus says that the boy wants to grow up just like his father. And in the last chorus the father realizes that his son did grow up just like him.

Many of us have children and parents. How are you doing? Are you honoring them today. God commands us to do so.


